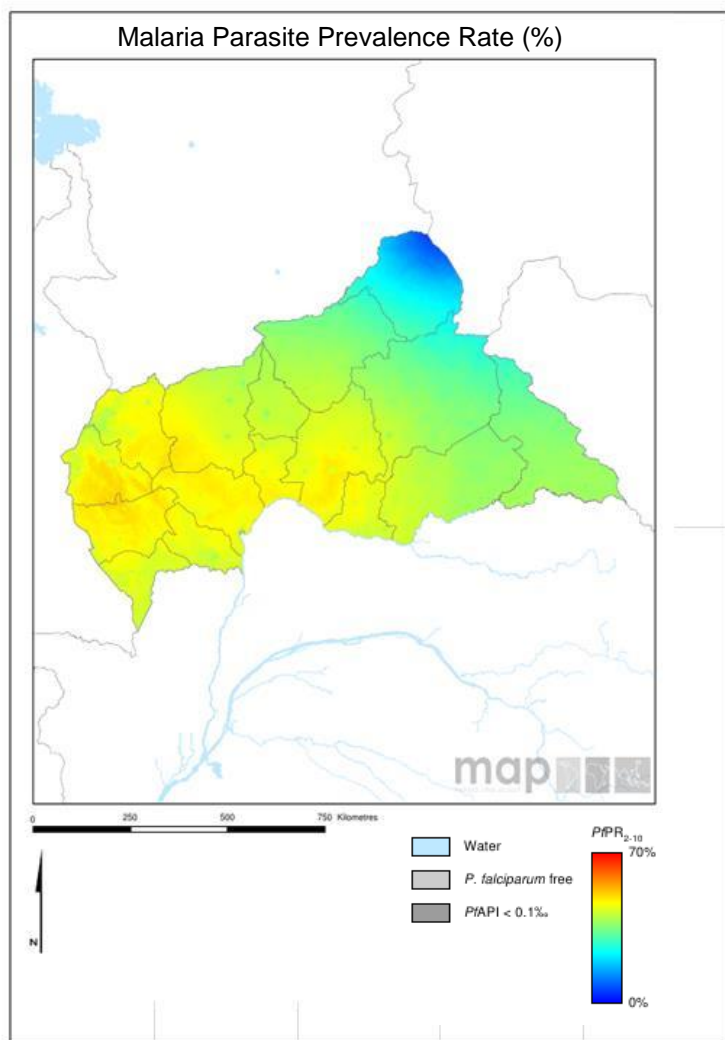

### Progress

Central African Republic has established a policy for Community Case Management of malaria and more recently, pneumonia. The country has also banned the import and sale of oral artemisinin-based monotherapies. The universal coverage campaign for LLINs is rolling out and will result in universal coverage of at risk populations. The country has made good progress in the tracer MNCH intervention of vitamin A coverage.

### Impact

The annual reported number of malaria cases in 2012 was 451,012 with 1,442 deaths.
