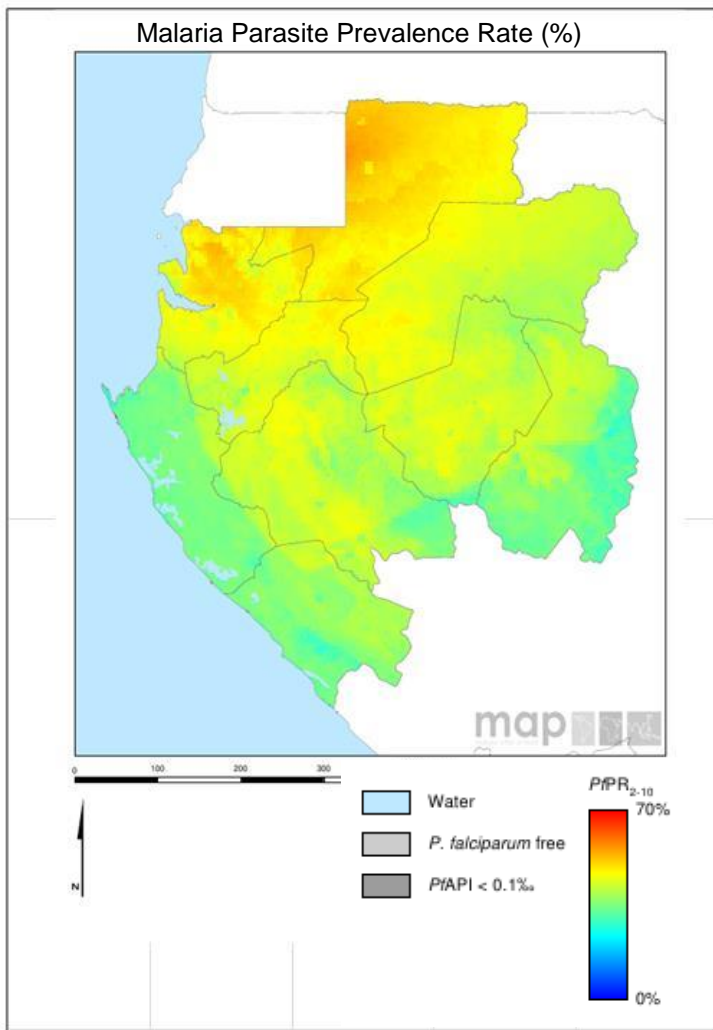


Scorecard for Accountability and Action



The entire population of Gabon is at high risk for malaria. Transmission is intense throughout the year in the northern part of the country and more seasonal in the south. The annual reported number of malaria cases in 2012 was 137,695 with 134 deaths.

Gabon ALMA Quarterly Report Quarter Three, 2014



Progress

Gabon has banned the importation and sale of oral artemisinin-based monotherapies, and introduced a policy on Community Case Management of pneumonia. Gabon has secured sufficient resources to finance the necessary ACTs required in 2014. The country has achieved high coverage of the tracer MNCH interventions of skilled birth attendants, PMTCT and DPT3 vaccination coverage.

Impact

The annual reported number of malaria cases in 2012 was 137,695 with 134 deaths.

Key Challenge

- Insufficient resources available to achieve universal coverage of essential malaria interventions.
