



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Malaria

Progress

Sudan has financed the essential malaria control commodities required to sustain high coverage in 2017. The country has carried out insecticide resistance monitoring since 2015 and has reported the results to WHO. Sudan has completed the insecticide resistance monitoring and management plan. Sudan has also scaled up the implementation of iCCM. The country has enhanced the tracking and accountability mechanisms for malaria with the development of a Malaria Control and Elimination Scorecard.

Impact

The annual reported number of malaria cases in 2016 was 897,194 with 984 deaths. WHO estimates that the country has recorded a change of less than 20% in the malaria incidence rate for the period 2010 - 2016.

Key Challenge

Insecticide resistance threatens vector control.

MNCH and NTDs

Progress

Sudan has achieved high coverage of the tracer MNCH indicator skilled birth attendants, exclusive breastfeeding and DPT3. The country has enhanced tracking and accountability mechanisms with the development of a Reproductive, Maternal, Newborn, Child and Adolescent Health Scorecard.

Progress in addressing Neglected Tropical Diseases (NTDs) in Sudan is measured using a composite index calculated from preventive chemotherapy coverage achieved for lymphatic filariasis, onchocerciasis, schistosomiasis, soil transmitted helminths and trachoma. Preventive chemotherapy coverage in Sudan is 53% for onchocerciasis and 36% for trachoma. Coverage is low for lymphatic filariasis (7%), schistosomiasis (24%), and soil transmitted helminths (7%). Overall, the NTD preventive chemotherapy coverage index for Sudan in 2016 is 19, which represents an increase compared with the 2015 index value (10).

Previous Key Recommended Action

Sudan has responded positively to the MNCH recommended action addressing low coverage of postnatal care and continues to track progress as this action is implemented.
