Progress

Togo has secured sufficient resources to fund the LLINs, RDTs and ACTs required in 2018. The country has distributed sufficient LLINs to achieve 100% operational coverage. Togo has finalised the national insecticide resistance monitoring and management plan.

Impact

The annual reported number of malaria cases in 2016 was 1,183,265 and 847 deaths.

Previous Key Recommended Action

Togo has responded positively to the recommended action on monitoring national insecticide resistance.

MNCH and NTDs

Progress

Togo achieved high coverage of the tracer MNCH intervention exclusive breastfeeding.

Progress in addressing Neglected Tropical Diseases (NTDs) in Togo is measured using a composite index calculated from preventive chemotherapy coverage achieved for lymphatic filariasis, onchocerciasis, schistosomiasis, and soil transmitted helminths. Preventive chemotherapy coverage in Togo is high for lymphatic filariasis (100%) and schistosomiasis (94%). Coverage is good for onchocerciasis (54%) and soil transmitted helminths (68%). Overall, the NTD preventive chemotherapy coverage index for Togo in 2016 is 77, which represents no change compared with the 2015 index value (78).
