



### **Progress**

Côte d'Ivoire has banned the import and sale of oral artemisinin-based monotherapies and has also introduced a policy on Community Case Management of malaria and pneumonia. Côte d'Ivoire has also successfully raised resources for the financing of the required number of LLINs, RDTs, and ACTs in 2015. The country has made progress on tracer MNCH interventions, with increased coverage of PMTCT and high coverage of vitamin A, postnatal care, and DPT3 vaccination.

### **Impact**

The annual reported number of malaria cases in 2013 was 4,708,425 with 3,261 deaths.
